The Planning Commission for the City of Canby met in regular session at the City Hall. Members present were John Bugess, John Rasmussen, Elsie Cutsforth, Dick McCarter and Jean Parsons, with John Rasmussen officiating in the absence of Ralph Hulbert.

In the secretary's absence no previous minutes were available.

There was no old business.

As new business, Phil Anderson presented plans for apartments between N. E. 4th and 5th Avenues. These to be in R1 zone, but the Commission felt that the zone could be changed by City Council to R2 before the zoning ordinance is passed.

Mr. Ed Eilers of the Bureau of Municipal Research presented maps showing rights of way. In question were Ferry Road and Knights Bridge Road. Mr. Eilers suggested that the city adopt the major streets plan. 60' was felt to be possible on Knights Bridge and 50' necessary on Ferry Road. The Commission suggested that Mr. Eilers check on streets as listed in "Major Streets in Canby" to gain a more realistic view of the proposed widths.
