

Minutes of the Planning Commission
of the City of Canby

April 18, 1962

The Planning Commission for the City of Canby met in regular session at the City Hall. Members present were John Rasmussen, Elsie Cutsforth, Jeanne Parsons and Chairman Ralph Hulbert, with ex-officio members Lee Cox and Lawrence Housen.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and corrected to show "McCarter property on Knights Bridge Road" and approved as corrected.

The Dodd subdivision plat was presented for final approval, and after examination motion was made by John Rasmussen, seconded by Jeanne Parsons that the Chairman be authorized to sign the plat as approved. Motion carried.


The McCarter subdivision plat was presented for approval and after discussion motion was made by Jeanne Parsons, seconded by Elsie Cutsforth that the preliminary plat submitted by Mrs. McCarter be approved. Motion carried.

Earl Cameron appeared before the Commission with a proposal for a street dedication on his property on Wait Avenue. After discussion motion was made by John Rasmussen, seconded by Elsie Cutsforth that it be recommended the City Council accept the proposed street as submitted for dedication by Mr. Cameron. Motion carried.

The subdivision of Canby Gardens by Tom and Earl Oliver was considered. Motion made by Rasmussen, seconded by Cutsforth that the preliminary plat be accepted as submitted with the exception that Anita Street should be widened to 50' and the commission would approve the unnamed street coming in from Locust Street to be cut to 50'. *MOTION CARRIED.*

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 10:00.
