REGULAR METTING OF City Planning Commission, May 20, 1964.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 8:15 p.m.

Present - Commissioners Cutsforth, Hulbert, Newton, Parsons and Rasmussen and Sup't Cox.

Minutes of the meeting of April 15 was read and approved.

Purchase of property on S.W. 3rd Avenue by Mrs. Goldie Arms, was discussed and no objection to her building application was registered so Sup't Cox was advised to issue the permit as applied for.

The Commission discussed ammending the Zoning ordinance to provide for tighter control over zone change applications. Chairman Hulbert said matters to be presented to the Commission for its study, should be in the Recorder's office by the Friday preceeding the regular meeting, and that the Commission could call emergency meetings for matters of immediate importance.

A motion was made by Commissioner Parsons, seconded by Cutsforth and carried unanimously that the Recorder be instructed that any business to appear on the agenda of the Planning Commission, be in the Recorder's office by Friday preceding the regular monthly meeting.

A motion was made by Commissioner Newton, seconded by Rasmussen and carried unanimously authorizing the Recorder or Secretary to write a letter to the City Council, asking them to redonsider their refusal of adoption of the planning control area program, in that the Planning Commission feels that it cannot function efficiently with out such an ordinance.

The meeting was adjourned at 10 p.m.
