CANBY PLANNING COMMISSION September 21, 1966

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hulbert at 8:08 P.M. with all commissioners present, with Mayor Stefani and Councilman Housen. Interested persons in attendance were Lyle Read and A. W. Walls.

Minutes of the August 17th meeting were approved as read.

After discussion, and the members being in agreement, motion was made by Zieg, seconded by Dresen, that the following boundaries be set for zone change from R-1 to C-2:

Beginning on the east side of South Ivy starting at the point where the city wellis located, and following the section line north to a 300' depth from South Ivy; from that point paralleling South Ivy until the section line intersects SE 4th; thence West to South Ivy, then South to the point of beginning.

The motion was carried.

No public hearing date was set pending determination by the City Recorder of the time required to obtain a proper legal description and names of property owners affected by the zone change for proper notification to them.

Mayor Stefani noted the director of the County Planning Department had offered the services of his staff to the City for consultation or technical assistance.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 9:20 P.M.
