It was noted there had been no opposition to parking plans of Canby Christian Church at the public hearing and the City Council had gwamkedwaleweenwale.given its approval to the plans for provision of off-street parking.

Discussion was had on extension of NE Juniper between 4th and 5th streets. No appearance was made by the interested property owners and no action taken.
