

CANBY PLANNING COMMISSION  
Regular Meeting - March 15, 1967

Present: Chairman Hulbert, Commissioners Newton, Cutsforth,  
Johnson, Dresen, Freeby; Councilman Tatone.

The meeting was called to order at 8:07 P.M.

Proposal of C. L. Madelen for ambulance building at inter-  
section of NE 3rd with NE 4th was discussed. General  
feeling of planning commission is that the location, size  
of streets, congestion of area would make for hazardous  
conditions for operation. Motion made by Dresen that  
no zone change or conditional use be granted. Seconded  
by Cutsforth and carried.

Cooperative private swimming pools discussed. Since this  
is the first time this has come up it was felt that we  
should be more informed on what other cities have done.  
Chairman Hulbert to inquire and report.

Letter received by Supt. Cox from David D. Fisher of  
Fisher, Wallin Architects, concerning Canby Baptist Church  
and enclosing preliminary plans. There was no objection to  
preliminary plans presented. ~~Axixixar~~ Motion was made by  
Johnson, seconded by Freeby and carried that a letter shall  
be sent to Canby Baptist Church advising them of the  
procedures of obtaining a conditional use in an R-1 zone.  
Letter to be sent by City Recorder, and to include references  
to Ordinance 452 and the application check list.

Canby's need for parks was again discussed. Chairman Hulbert  
asked the commissioners to think about possible park areas  
and financing methods, and suggested attendance at a budget  
committee meeting.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at  
10:33 P.M.
