

CANBY PLANNING COMMISSION

May 17, 1967

The regular meeting of the planning commission was called to order by Chairman Hulbert at 8:05 P.M. with all commissioners present. Also present was councilman John Tatone.

There was no agenda. However Mr. Hulbert introduced Mr. Dale R. Goldsmith who had asked for time to make a presentation to the Commission on the advantages of mobile homeliving within the city. Mr. Goldsmith felt a quality mobile home would not be out of place in a permanent setting on a city lot to be purchased for that purpose.

The unofficial feeling of the commission was that the only satisfactory solution might be a subdivision set aside exclusively for mobile homes.
