

CANBY PLANNING COMMISSION  
Regular Meeting  
September 10, 1969

Present: Chairman Ralph Hulbert, Commissioners Al Godfrey, Curt Johnson, Andy DiTommaso, Gordon Ross, and Jeanne Parsons. Carl Raines, Council representative, John Tatone, Councilman and Jim Webb from the County Planning Commission were also present.

The meeting was brought to order by the Chairman at 8:15 P.M. The Chairman dispensed with the minutes of the last meeting.

Mr. Eugene Cole, Manager of the Canby Telephone Association, asked the Planning Commission's consideration on expansion of the Telephone Company's installation. It was suggested that this could be either a conditional use in the existing R-2 zone or rezoned to C-2.

The Planning Commission members discussed high density multiple family units. They felt that the existing multiple family dwellings were of too high density and discussed the feasibility of dividing the zones into several zones of differing densities. Further study will be made.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
