

CANBY PLANNING COMMISSION
Regular Meeting
February 12, 1969

Present: Chairman Ralph Hulbert, Commissioners Roy Bentz, Elsie Cutsforth, Jeanne Parsons, Andy DiTommaso, Al Godfrey, City Council representative Carl Raines, Councilman John Tatone, and Jim Webb from the County Planning Commission.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 8:05 P.M. Minutes of the January 8th regular meeting and the January 22nd special hearing were read. Minutes of the January 22nd hearing are hereby corrected to read "five (5) yeas, making the decision unanimous", instead of "six (6) yeas, making the decision unanimous".

The Commission discussed the problems of streets and roads within the city boundaries. The extension of S. E. 2nd Street was thoroughly discussed, and advice was asked of Jim Webb from the County Planning Commission. He stated he could see no useful purpose in extending S. E. 2nd Street at this time. Motion was made by DiTommaso, seconded by Cutsforth, that a recommendation be made to the City Council that considering all facts, there is no necessity for extending S.E. 2nd Street at this time. Majority of the Commission voted yea. The secretary was instructed to draft a recommendation to the City Council, and a copy of the recommendation is attached to the minutes.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:00 P.M.
