

Canby Planning Commission
Special Meeting
December 22, 1971

Present: Chairman Gordon Ross, Commissioners Edgerton, DiTommaso, Johnson
Cutsforth, Hulbert and Neeley.

Also present: Asst. Supt. Whiteside.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 pm.

The minutes of the December 14th meeting were read.

First on the agenda was a public hearing on the Salway continuance of Dec. 14th, for the consideration of a conditional use application for the construction of a ³²37 bed nursing home on property located at 1105 S. Elm St. After a short discussion with the applicant, Commissioner Neeley moved the application be granted subject to the following conditions:

1. The applicant deed ten feet (10') frontage to the City of Canby for future widening of S. Elm St.
2. The side yard setback to be no less than ten feet (10') from furthest projection of the building on the Clinic side of property.
3. The North side yard setback to be no less than 16 feet (16') from furthest projection.
4. Parking to allow for no less than 19 spaces.
5. A green hedge shall be planted on property line between clinic and nursing home adjacent to service entrance.

Motion seconded by Johnson and passed unanimously.

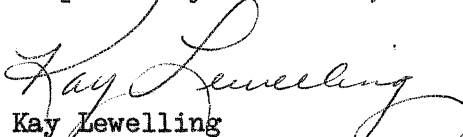
The Secretary was directed to write a letter to Mr. & Mrs. Salway advising them of the decision of the Commission.

Mr. Whiteside then recommended that the Commission recommend to the City Council that South Elm St. be widened from 40 foot to 60 foot right-of-way with a minimum of 50 feet of paving, since it will become a collector street. Commissioner Cutsforth moved the council be so advised, second by Hulbert and passed unanimously.

Next on agenda, Chairman Ross presented proposed changes to the subdivision ordinance. A copy of these proposed changes are attached and made a permanent part of these minutes. Discussion followed. Commissioner Johnson moved the proposed changes be adopted. Second by DiTommaso and passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:45 pm.
