A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING USE OF THE MEETING ROOM AND KITCHEN AT GRANT STREET FIRE STATION BY CANBY VOLUNTEER FIREMEN'S ASSOCIATION.


WHEREAS, The Canby Volunteer Firemen's Association has for many years used with the approval of the Canby City Council the meeting room and kitchen of the Grant Street Fire Station, and during that period have, at their own expense, provided miscellaneous and sundry items of furnishings and equipment; and

WHEREAS, from time to time other persons and organizations in the City of Canby have used said facilities on request and with consent of either the City Council or the City Fire Department, and there is a need to establish responsibility with respect to the use of said facilities, and it is necessary and advisable that the Canby Volunteer Firemen's Association be given the exclusive right and authority to exercise control and use of said facilities in connection with their activities as volunteer firemen for the City of Canby, and it is therefore hereby,


RESOLVED, That a Consent to Use Agreement by the Canby City Council to the Canby Volunteer Firemen's Association be approved and signed on behalf of the City and to said Association and in the form of the attached "Exhibit A" which the Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized to execute and deliver.
