RESOLUTION NO. CLXVII

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE CITY'S POSITION ON THE PROPOSED OREGON CITY BY-PASS.

WHEREAS, the State Transportation Commission is conducting a study of the necessity and feasibility of constructing the so-called Oregon City By-Pass which, among other things, will relieve traffic congestion in the residential and urban areas of Oregon City and its environs of which Canby is a part; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council is aware of the traffic, transportation and growth problems of Clackamas County and has considered
the proposed plan for construction of the Oregon City By-Pass, and
intends by this Resolution to indicate its unequivocal and wholehearted support of the project; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Canby City Council that it unanimously supports and approves and joins with others similarly interested and concerned in hereby urging the Oregon Transportation Commission to allow the expenditure of necessary funds to complete the construction of the Oregon City By-Pass and all of the necessary facilities related to that project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be filed by the City Recorder with the Board of County Commissioners of Clack-amas County, the City Council of Oregon City, and the State Transportation Commission.
