

ORDINANCE NO. 1-A

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF BICYCLES: FORBIDDING THE USE AND PARKING OF BICYCLES ON SIDEWALKS OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of any bicycle to ride or park the same upon any sidewalk or path constructed for the use of, and commonly used by pedestrians within the corporate limits of the Town of Troutdale.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction therefor before the Recorder of the Town of Troutdale, be punished by a fine of not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$10.00 or by imprisonment in the town jail not less than one day nor more than five days or by both such fine and imprisonment; or the bicycle involved may be impounded for a period of not less than five (5) or more than thirty (30) days.

SECTION 3. The immediate passage of this Ordinance is found to be a necessity for the safety of the residents of the Town of Troutdale, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
