

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING C. E. CARTER, ENGINEER FOR THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE TO PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE LAYING OF A SIX (6) INCH WATER MAIN FROM THE WATER WORKS SPRING AND TANK ON THE FORMER PROPERTY OF W.C. SPENCE, DIAGONALLY DOWN HILL ACROSS W. C. SPENCE'S PRIVATE PROPERTY, AND THE PRIVATE PROPERTY OF A.D. KENDALL TO A CONNECTION WITH THE PRESENT WATER MAIN AT WILLAMETTE AND CELESTIA STREETS AND TO CALL FOR BIDS FOR THE INSTALLATION AND LAYING OF SAID SIX INCH PIPE COMPLETE, AND AUTHORIZING THE ENGINEER TO PURCHASE THE PIPE FROM PACIFIC STATES CAST IRON PIPE CO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. That the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale deems it to the public's interests, and that the public health, peace and safety of the residents and inhabitants of said Town of Troutdale will be safe-guarded, improved and protected by the installation and operation of a new, additional and larger water main from the spring and tank on the Water Works grounds to the lower and business section of the town, in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by C. E. Carter, Engineer, which plans and specifications are hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That said C. E. Carter, Engineer, be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to obtain bids for the laying and installing said six inch water main, according to the plans and specifications heretofore prepared by said Engineer (copies of which shall be filed with the Recorder of this Town of Troutdale) and to report the said bids to this Council and for filing with the Recorder.

SECTION 3. In as much as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the residents and inhabitants of the Town of Troutdale, in this, that the water supply in the immediate vicinity to be served by said six inch water main is inadequate, and should be improved at the earliest possible date, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage.
