An Ordinance emending subsection (b) of Section 10 of an ordinance numbered 3 of the Town of Troutdale, passed by the Council December 5, 1942, approved by the Mayor January 1, 1943, entitled.

"an Ordinance granting to the Fortland General Electric Company, an Oregon corporation, its successors and assigns, for a period of 20 years from and after the effective date of this ordinance, the right and privilege to erect, construct, maintain and operate with-in the corporate limits of the Town of Treutdale, Oregon, as such limits now exist or may be hereafter constituted, an electric light and power system with the right and privilege to erect, maintain and operate poles, wires, fixtures and equipment necessary to supply the said sity and inhabitants thereof, and others, with electric energy for light, power and other purposes, upon, over, along, and across the streets, reads, alleys, and other public ways and places within the corporate limits of the said Town of Troutdale, fixing the terms and conditions thereof, and declaring an emergency,"

increasing the franchise fees to be paid by Fortland General Electric Company.

BE IT CEDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section.1. That subsection (b) of Section 10 of Ordinance No. 3 of the Town of Troutdale, passed by the Common Council December 5, 1942, approved by the Mayor January 1, 1943, and entitled.

"An Ordinance granting to the Fortland General Electric Company, an Oregon corporation, its successors and assigns, for a period of 20 years from and after the effective date of this ordinance, the right and privilege to creet, construct, maintain and operate within the corporate limits of the Town of Troutdale, Oregon, as such limits now exist or may be hereefter constituted, an electric light and power system with the right and privilege to creet, maintain and operate poles, wires, fixtures and equipment necessary to supply the said city and inhabitants thereof, and others, with electric energy for light,

power and other purposes, upon, over, along and across the streets, roads, alleys, and other public ways and places within the corporate limits of the said from of Troutdale, fixing the terms and conditions thereof, and declaring an emergency,"

Be and the same is hereby arouded to read as follows:

"(b) That in consideration of the rights and privileges herein granted, and as compensation for the franchise, the said Portland Ceneral Electric Company shall pay to the form of Troutdele, on or before the 15th day of January of each and every year during the term of this franchise the sum of One Hundred Thirty (\$150.00) Dollars. In consideration of the agreement of the ommony to make such payments. the city agrees that no special license, tax or charge on the business, occupation or franchise of the said Portland General Electric Company, shall, during the term of this ordinamed, be imposed upon, exacted from or required of the said Portland Conoral Sleetric Company, but this provision shall not exempt the property of the said Fortland General Elsetrie Company from lawful taxation, or exempt said company from an occupational tax, if such tax is generally levied in said city. Each of the annual payments of money required by this scation shall be made by said Portland General Electric Company to the Recorder of the Town of Troutdale, and the said Recorder shall issue his receipt therefor, which shell be full acquittance of said Fortland General Electric Company for such payments. Should

eaid Pertland General Electric Company fail or neglect for thirty (30) days after the same shall become due and payable and after written notice from the Town of Troutdale to pay any of said annual payments provided for in this section, the Town of Troutdale, by its properly constituted authorities, may at its option, either continue this franchise in force and proceed by suit or action to collect said payment, or declars a forfeiture of this franchise because of the failure to make such payment, but without waiving its

right to collect cerned franchise payments."
