ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING DEPOSITING, PLACING OR DUMPING OF DECOMPOSED ANIMAL OR VEGETABLE MATTER, TIN CANS, CARBAGE OR OTHER REFUSE UPON ANY STREET, HIGHWAY, ROAD, ALLEY OR THOROUGHFARE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to deposit, place or dump any decomposed animal or vegetable matter, tin cans, garbage or other refuse upon any street, highway, road, alley or thoroughfare within the corporate limits of the Town of Troutdale.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to deposit, place or dump any refuse, garbage, tin cans, decomposed vegatable or animal matter on any land owned by the Town of Troutdale within the corporate limits of the Town of Troutdale, in Multnomah County, Oregon.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction therefor, before the City Recorder of the Town of Troutdale, be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than one day, nor more than ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the residents and inhabitants of the Town of Troutdale, in this:- That in order to promote the health and safety of the public in the use of streets, highways, roads, alleys and public thoroughfares within the Town of Troutdale, without delay, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
