

ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT CERTAIN STREET AREA FIFTY (50) FEET IN WIDTH, BEGINNING AT A POINT IN THE SOUTH LINE OF COLUMBIA STREET, A PART OF COLUMBIA RIVER HIGHWAY, 200 FEET WEST OF THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF WILLAMETTE STREET AND COLUMBIA STREET, IN THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE; RUNNING THENCE SOUTH 200 FEET TO THE POINT OF INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTH LINE OF CELESTIA STREET, EXTENDED, THENCE WEST 50 FEET; THENCE NORTH 200 FEET TO THE SOUTH LINE OF COLUMBIA RIVER HIGHWAY (COLUMBIA STREET); THENCE EAST 50 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, SHALL BE GIVEN A NAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared that the Street area 50 feet in width described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the South line of Columbia Street, a part of Columbia River Highway, 200 feet west of the southwest corner of Willamette and Columbia Streets, in the Town of Troutdale; running thence south 200 feet to the point of intersection with the north line of Celestia Street, extended, thence west 50 feet; thence north 200 feet to the south line of Columbia River Highway (Columbia Street); thence east 50 feet to the place of beginning, be, and it is hereby named KENDALL STREET, in honor of a much-loved and respected citizen and resident of the Town of Troutdale.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect 30 days from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.
