

ORDINANCE No. 25

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL GARBAGE CONTAINERS TO BE OF METAL CONSTRUCTION, AND EQUIPPED WITH METAL LID OR COVER.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep, handle or deposit garbage in any receptacle other than in a non-leakable metal container, equipped with metal lid or cover.

Section 2. No garbage receptacle<sup>or</sup> containing garbage or refuse shall be allowed to remain uncovered without lid or cover.

Section 3. All garbage shall be removed or carried out of the corporate limits of the Town of Troutdale at not later than weekly intervals, nor shall same be allowed to remain within the Town of Troutdale undisposed of for any period longer than one week.

Section 4. Any uncovered garbage or refuse, whether in a receptacle or not, or undisposed of as required in Section 3 of this Ordinance, shall constitute a nuisance.

Section 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, or on failure to pay fine, be confined in the City Jail in the Town of Troutdale, one day for each \$5.00 of such fine.

Section 6. It is hereby declared that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation and protection of the Public health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and signed by the Mayor.
