ORDINANCE No. 26

An Ordinance forbidding the burial of carcasses of (dead) animals, within that part of the Town of Troutdale located south of the south line of Sandy Road (Columbia Highway) also known as Columbia Street, and west of the east line of D. F. Buxton, D.L.C. in the S.W.quarter of Section 25, Township 1 north of Range 3 east of W.M. in the Town of Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL, OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to bury the carcass of any (dead) animal or animals in the ground or soil any where within that part of the Town of Troutdale, Oregon, that is located south of the south line of Sandy Road (Columbia Highway) also known as Columbia Street, and west of the east line of the D.F.Buxton D.L.C. in the S.W. quarter of Section 25, Township 1 north of Range 3 east of W.M. in the Town of Troutdale, Multnomah County, Oregon.

Section 2. The burial of the carcass of a (dead) animal in the soil in the area described in Section 1 of this Ordinance, is hereby declared to constitute a Public nuisance, detrimental to the health and safety of the residents and inhabitants of the Town of Troutdale, Oregon.

Section 3. Any person found guilty of the violation of this Ordinance, shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$\psi\$ or more than \$\psi\$ or incarcerated in the City Jail not less than days nor more than days, at the discretion of the Judge of the Municipal Court of the Town of Troutdale.

Section 4. It is hereby declared that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation and protection of the Public health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and signed by the Mayor.
