

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
COMBINING OF THE OFFICES OF
MARSHAL AND MAINTENANCE MAN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1.

The offices of Marshal and Maintenance Man of the
Town of Troutdale as heretofore established by the Common
Council shall be combined and one person as appointed and
qualified by the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale
shall hold both these offices.

SECTION 2.

The duties of the office of Marshal and the duties
of the office of Maintenance Man shall each include all duties
customarily assigned to each such office and in addition thereto
all duties now or hereafter assigned to each such office by
ordinance of the Town of Troutdale.

SECTION 3.

WHEREAS, it is hereby adjudged and declared that
existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary
for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
safety of the Town of Troutdale;

NOW, THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to
exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full
force and effect when signed by the Mayor.
