

ORDINANCE NO. 44

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10 OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND SIGNED BY THE MAYOR MAY 14, 1946, (AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 14, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND SIGNED BY THE MAYOR DECEMBER 10, 1946), BY ADDING THERETO SECTION 2 (a) PROVIDING FOR CHARGING WATER SERVICES TO THE PREMISES SERVED AND FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF WATER SERVICE ON DELINQUENCY IN PAYMENT OF SUCH CHARGES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. WHEREAS, the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale on May 14, 1946, duly passed Ordinance No. 10, entitled

AN ORDINANCE FIXING WATER RATES AND CHARGES TO BE PAID BY WATER USERS CONNECTED WITH THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM OR WATER WORKS OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE.

which was on the same date signed by the Mayor, and

WHEREAS on December 10, 1946, said council duly passed Ordinance No. 14, amending Ordinance No. 10, entitled

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 10 OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE MAY 14th, 1946, BY ADDING SECTIONS 1-(a) and 1-(b) and 1-(c) GOVERNING THE USE OF WATER FROM THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE.

which was on the same date signed by the Mayor, and

WHEREAS said Council now finds that said Ordinance No. 10 should now be further amended by adding a section providing for charging water services to the premises served, and for discontinuance of water service to such premises in the event of delinquency in payment of charges for such water service,

NOW THEREFORE said Ordinance No. 10 hereby is amended by adding a section numbered Section 2 (a), which amendment shall read as follows:

Section 2 (a). All charges for furnishing water within the Town of Troutdale and also to premises outside the Town served directly by its Municipal Water System shall be chargeable to the premises where water is supplied. Whenever any charge for furnishing water to any premises shall not be paid within ten days after the same becomes due and payable, the Marshal of the Town of Troutdale shall discontinue the service of water to such premises. Water shall not again be furnished thereto until all outstanding obligations for water supplied to such premises shall have been paid in full.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of the Town of Troutdale in that it is essential and in the public interest that the Town of Troutdale be immediately provided an effective and efficient means of enforcement of payment of bills for water charges now delinquent or which may become delinquent;

NOW THEREFORE, it is declared that an emergency exists, and this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after it is passed by the Common Council and signed by the Mayor.

Passed by the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale, this 10th day of July, 1956.
