ORDINANCE NO. 45

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF THE CITY CONVENTION METHOD FOR HOMINATING ELECTIVE OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Momination of elective officers of the Town of Troutdale shall be made by convention of voters set in city convention as authorised by the statutes of the state of Oregon. (ORE 221.190 (1) (c))

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of the Town of Troutdale for the reason that nominations must be made for those elective officers of such town which are to be elected at the general election to be held November 6, 1956; now, therefore, it is declared that an emergency exists, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect immediately from and after its passage by the Common Council and its signing by the Mayor.
