

ORDINANCE NO. 51

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND SIGNED BY THE MAYOR JANUARY 20, 1942, BY ADDING THERETO RULE 27 AS A PART OF SECTION 1, PROVIDING FOR ADVANCE FILING OF WRITTEN NOTICE OF INTENTION TO BRING MATTERS BEFORE A COUNCIL MEETING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. Whereas the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale on January 20, 1942, duly passed Ordinance No. 1 entitled "AN ORDINANCE MAKING AND PROVIDING RULES FOR THE ORDER OF BUSINESS OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THERESWITH AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY", which was on the same day signed by the Mayor; and

Whereas said Council now finds that said Ordinance No. 1 should now be further amended by adding a rule to Section 1, thereby providing for the filing of advance written notice of intention to bring matters before a Council meeting;

Now, Therefore, said Ordinance No. 1 is hereby amended by adding a rule numbered 27 to Section 1 thereof, which amendment shall read as follows:

"Rule 27. No matter shall be brought before a Council meeting by one not a member of the Council unless written notice of intention to do so shall have been filed with the Recorder at least 7 ~~days~~ DAYS prior to the opening of the meeting."

SECTION 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Troutdale;

Now, Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect when signed by the Mayor.
