

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE CITY RECORDER TO CHARGE FOR FURNISHING COPIES OF OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. The City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to charge a fee as provided herein for the furnishing of a copy of any official document of the Town, which shall include copies of City Ordinances and the City Charter.

SECTION 2. Such fee shall be set by the City Recorder and shall be based on the approximate actual cost of making, storing and furnishing such copies.

SECTION 3. The proceeds of said fees shall be placed in the General Fund of the Town.

SECTION 4. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Town of Troutdale;

Now, Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect when signed by the Mayor.
