

ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO WATER RATES DURING SUMMER MONTHS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 61, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 61, passed by the Council and signed by the Mayor on October 11, 1960, is hereby amended by the addition of the following section:

Section. That the water rates charged by the Town of Troutdale for water used during the months of July, August and September of each year shall be reduced so that for the minimum charge of \$2.00 the water user shall be entitled to 4500 gallons. All water used in excess of 4500 gallons shall be charged at the rates above set forth.

SECTION 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect with respect to rates charged for the month of July, 1961.
