

ORDINANCE NO. 86

AN ORDINANCE SEPARATING THE FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE OF RECORDER AND MUNICIPAL JUDGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION I. The offices of the City Recorder and Municipal Judge are hereby separated and may not hereafter be carried out by the same individual.

SECTION 2. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation to public health, peace and safety of the people of the Town of Troutdale and the judgment of the Common Council, now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be enforced and in effect from and after its passing by the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale and its signing by the mayor.
