

ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE relating to load limits on Jackson Park Road and providing penalties. Declaring an emergency and providing an effective date.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. No person shall operate any motor vehicles on that part of Jackson Park Road located within the Town of Troutdale having a gross weight in excess of 6,000 pounds, including any loading thereon, without having first obtained special permission from the Mayor or his designated representative. Said permission may be granted by said Mayor or his designated representative upon a showing of good cause therefor. Any violation of this Ordinance shall subject violator to a fine of not more than \$500.00 or to imprisonment of not more than 30 days in the County Jail.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be first effective on the 1st day of August, 1967.

Section 3. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Troutdale and of the credit of said town that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefor, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
