

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING JUNK, PROHIBITING THE KEEPING THEREOF IN CERTAIN PLACES IN THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE, PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. JUNK. The term "junk" shall include all old motor vehicles, old motor vehicle parts, abandoned automobiles, old machinery, old machinery parts, old appliances or parts thereof, old iron, or other metal, glass, paper, old lumber, old wood, or other waste or discarded material.

Section 2. It is hereby determined and declared that the keeping of any junk out of doors on any street, lot, or premises within the town of Troutdale, or in a building that is not wholly or entirely enclosed except doors for use of ingress and egress, is a nuisance and is unlawful.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, or the agent or employee of any person, to keep any junk out of doors on any street, or on any lot or premises within the Town of Troutdale, or in a building that is not wholly or entirely enclosed except for doors used for ingress and egress.

Section 4. It shall be the duty of the Town Marshall of the Town of Troutdale to give written notice to owner or lessee of the private land upon which such junk is situated, giving notice that keeping of said junk violates this ordinance and demanding that the same be removed from the Town of Troutdale within seventy-two (72) hours, or that within seventy-two (72) hours the said junk be housed in a building or where it will not be visible from the street.

Section 5. If the notice is given, as provided in Section 4, and a person upon whom the said notice and demand is made shall fail to remove said junk or shall fail to cause the same to be housed in building where it will not be visible from the street, then said person shall be violation of this Ordinance, and on conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the City jail for a term not exceeding six (6) months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Town of Troutdale in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they do conflict.

Section 7. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of the Town of Troutdale the judgment of the Common Council, now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale and its signing by the Mayor.
