ORDINANCE NO. 90

AN ORDINANCE relating to surcharges upon water users for construction, maintenance and operation of sewer mains, sewage disposal plant, and matters connected therewith, providing for such surcharges and their collection and the disposal of moneys collected under the provisions of this ordinance. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

TOWN

Be it ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OT TROUTDALE:

Section 1. That a surcharge amounting to \$2.00 per month shall be

collected from each user of water furnished by the municipal water works of the low of Troutdale. The said amount shall be added to the charges for use of municipal water collected under such use from and after the day of law, 1967, and shall be included in the monthly bill of date of law, 1967 and monthly thereafter.

Section 2. All funds collected under the provisions of this ordinance shall be placed in a separate fund to be designated "Sewer Fund", and shall be expended only upon warrants authorized by the common council and drawn against such fund for the purpose of constructing, maintaining and operating sewer mains and a disposal plant and matters connected therewith and for the purpose of paying the principal and interest upon bonds issued.

Section 3. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the city of Troutdale and of the inhabitants thereof, and to preserve the credit of said city that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefor, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council, and approval by the Mayor.
