

ORDINANCE NO. 92

An Ordinance relating to the Conduct of Elections and the referral of measures and Amendments to The Town Charter. Repealing Ordinance No. 56 adopted September 9, 1958 and Amending Ordinance No. 2 adopted January 20, 1942; declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Whereas the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale

on September 9, 1958, duly passed Ordinance No. 56 entitled, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF TROUTDALE, PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND SIGNED BY THE MAYOR ON JANUARY 20, 1942, BY AMENDING SECTION 6 OF ARTICLE II THEREOF, PROVIDING FOR THE TIME AND MANNER OF SUBMITTING A MEASURE, CHARTER OR CHARTER AMENDMENT TO THE VOTERS BY THE COMMON COUNCIL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY." which was on the same day signed by the Mayor; and

Whereas, said Council now finds that said Ordinance No. 56 should be repealed and Section 6 of Ordinance 2 should be amended for purposes of clarification;

NOW THEREFORE said Ordinance 56 is repealed and Section 6 of Ordinance 2, "The Initiative and Referendum Ordinance of the Town of Troutdale" is amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. The Common Council may, by resolution, authorize the submission of a charter, charter amendment or other measure prepared under the direction of the Common Council. Such charter amendment may be submitted not sooner than the eleventh day following the posting of Notices of Election as required by Section 25, Chapter VI of the Charter for the Town of Troutdale nor later than the thirtieth day following the adoption of said resolution. The date of such resolution appearing on the minutes and records of the Town Record shall be prima facie evidence of the date said resolution was adopted."

Section 2. Whereas the amendment effected by said Ordinance 56 and by this ordinance conflict with the language of Section 24 of Ordinance No. 2, and

Whereas the Section 25, Chapter VI of the Charter for the Town of Troutdale also conflicts with Section 24 of Ordinance No. 2;

Now therefore said Section 24 of Ordinance No. 2 is amended so that paragraph (1), sub-paragraph (b) shall read as follows:

"(b) posted in three (3) public places in each precinct in the town not earlier than 12:01 A.M. of the twentieth day before the day set for the election nor later than required by Section 25, Chapter VI of the Charter For The Town of Troutdale".


Section 3. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Troutdale and of the credit of said Town that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
