## ORDINANCE NO. 93

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS AND THE REFERRAL OF MEASURES AND AMENDMENTS TO THE TOWN CHARTER, AND THE EFFECT OF MEASURES; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2 ADOPTED JANUARY 20, 1942; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Section 26 of Ordinance No. 2 is amended to read as

follows:

"Section 26. Advertising Measure. In case of the submission of a measure to the voters the recorder, under the direction of the council, not earlier than 12:01 A.M. of the twentieth day before the day set for the election nor later than the date required by Section 25, Chapter VI of the Charter For The Town of Troutdale for giving notice of each town election, shall cause it to be----

- 1. published in two consecutive issues of a newspaper of general circulation in the town or
- in each precinct 2. posted in three public places/in the town."

Sub-paragraph (b), paragraph (2), Section 28 of Ordinance No. 2 is amended to read as follows:

"(b) posting copies of it in three public places in each precinct in the town."

Section 2. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Troutdale and of the credit of said town that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
