ORDINANCE NO. 96

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO REGULAR AND SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE TOWN COUNCIL; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1.

Be it ordained by the COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 1 is amended so that Rule 26 shall read as follows:

The regular meetings of the Council shall be held on the second Tuesday of each month at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in the City Hall; with the consent of all members of the Council, however, the said regular meeting may be held on a different date where a good cause appears therefore. A special meeting shall be held at such time as the Mayor may direct upon call of the Mayor or upon request of not less than three members of the Council; provided, however, that notice of such special meeting shall be given to each member of the Council either in person, by messenger, or by telephone not less than two hours prior to the time affixed for said meeting. No other business than that for which a special meeting is called can be transacted at the special meeting.

Section 2. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Troutdale and of the credit of said Town that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
