

ORDINANCE NO. 102 .

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ANNEXATION OF PROPOSED WEEDIN SUB-DIVISION;  
FIXING A DAY AND TIME FOR PUBLIC HEARING IN COMPLIANCE WITH ORS 222.120,  
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE DO ORDAIN:

WHEREAS IT APPEARS to the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale that the  
legal owners of the hereinafter described real property, to-wit:

AA tract of land in Section 36, T. 1 N. R. 3 E. of the W.M., part of which  
lies within boundaries of the City of Troutdale, in the County of Multnomah  
and State of Oregon, described as follows: Beginning in the north line of  
the John Douglass Donation Land Claim 825 feet east of the northwest corner  
thereof, being the center line of Troutdale Road, No. 1674; thence East  
along the North line of said John Douglass Donation Land Claim to the north-  
east corner thereof; thence south along the east line of said John Douglass  
Donation Land Claim to the northeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to  
John L. Douglass by deed recorded on July 8, 1871 in Deed Book "0", page 419;  
thence west along the north line of said John L. Douglass tract to the center  
line of Troutdale Road, No. 1674; thence north along the center line of said  
road to the place of beginning. Subject to the rights of the Public in the  
roads and to any portion of the above property lying below high water mark  
of the Beaver Creek and subject to the rights of Fayette L. Weedon and Betty J.  
Weedon to possession of the cultivated land until January 1, 1963.

have filed a Request and Consent to annexation to the Town of Troutdale and;

SECTION 1. Whereas it is the intent of the Common Council to consent  
to said annexation without a vote of the people pursuant to the provisions  
of ORS 222.120 unless it is shown to them that a majority of the People of  
the Town of Troutdale oppose said annexation or desire that an election be  
held on the question of annexation

Therefore be it ordained that:

1). A public hearing be held at the Troutdale Town Hall on the 30  
day of January, 1968 at the hour of 7:30 P.M.; and

2). Notice of said public hearing be published in the Gresham Outlook  
a newspaper of general circulation in the Town of Troutdale, for two successive  
weeks prior to said hearing; and

3). Notice of said hearing be posted in four public places in the  
Town of Troutdale for two successive weeks prior to said hearing.

SECTION 2. Inasmuch as this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate  
preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of the Town  
of Troutdale in the judgment of the Common Council, now, therefore, an emergency  
is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in force and effect  
from and after its passage by the Common Council of the Town of Troutdale and  
its signing by the Mayor.
