ORDINANCE NO. 113_

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO LICENSING BUSINESSES, TRADES, CALLINGS, PROFESSIONS, PURSUITS AND OCCUPATIONS IN THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE, PROVIDING PENALTIES, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 62; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE.

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance 62 is emended to read as follows: "Section 4. No person shall engage in or pursue a business in the Town of Troutdale unless he shall have first obtained a license therefore and paid to the Town Recorder a license fee of \$15.00 annually. By special action of the Town Council a license for less than a year may be issued."

Section 2. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Town of Troutdale and of the credit of said Town that this Ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
