AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE TOWN WATER SUPPLY, AMERDING ORDINANCE 99 and DECLARING AN ENERGEBECY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE.

SECTION 1. Section 8 of the Water Supply Code is smended to read as follows:

"Section 8. The meter shall be installed at or near the property line. The cost of the meter and installation shall be paid by the property owner to the Town on the basis of the following formula:

(1) Cost of the mater plus (2) cost of the pipe and materials that would be required to carry said service to the middle of the street in which the main lies plus one-third of (1) and (2) which the Council finds to be the approximate cost to the Town of labor and other expense in connection with the making of such installations. This charge shall be the total charge of installation."

SECTION 2. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the Town of Troutdale and of the inhabitants thereof, and to preserve the credit of said Town that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
