

ORDINANCE NO. 121

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PLACING OF ANY MATTER, THING OR SUBSTANCE UPON ANY STREET, HIGHWAY, ROAD, ALLEY, THOROUGHFARE OR SIDEWALK OR PROPERTY OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE ~~WITHIN~~ THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE: PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF: REPEALING ORDINANCE 16 and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE.

SECTION 1, Ordinance No. 16 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to place any matter, thing or substance upon any street, highway, road, alley, thoroughfare, sidewalk or property of the Town of Troutdale except as otherwise specifically permitted by Ordinance.


SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction therefore, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment of not more than ten days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the Town of Troutdale, and of inhabitants thereof, and to preserve the credit of said town that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
