

ORDINANCE NO. 129

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE TROUTDALE CITY JUDGE AND COURT,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. Attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof is a true copy of an agreement entered into between the City of Troutdale and Multnomah County. So long as such agreement continues in effect, trials involving the violation of Troutdale City Ordinances shall be tried by a Judge of the District Court for the State of Oregon for the County of Multnomah.

SECTION 2. The trial and all proceedings in connection with the violation of Troutdale City Ordinances shall be conducted in all respects with all of the attendant rights that a defendant would have were he being tried in District Court for the violation of any criminal statute of the State of Oregon.

SECTION 3. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Troutdale and of the inhabitants thereof, and to preserve the credit of said City that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

**Order of the Execution of an  
Agreement Between MULTNOMAH COUNTY,  
and TROUTDALE, OREGON, for the  
Exercise of Functions and Activities  
Government Involving Violation  
Cases of the City of Troutdale.**

**ORDER**

The above-entitled matter is before the Board to con-  
sider the execution of an agreement between Multnomah County,  
and Troutdale, Oregon, providing that the District Court  
of Oregon for the County of Multnomah shall have  
jurisdiction to hear and try violations of ordinances of the  
City of Troutdale; and

It appearing to the Board that Multnomah County and  
the City of Troutdale desire that jurisdiction to hear and de-  
termine cases involving violations of city ordinances of Trout-  
dale be vested in the District Court of the State of Oregon for  
the County of Multnomah for a period of one year from the date  
of said agreement and that all fines and forfeitures resulting  
from said cases shall be remitted by the Clerk of the District  
Court to the General Fund of Multnomah County and shall become  
county funds; and

It further appearing that the terms and conditions of  
said agreement are satisfactory to Multnomah County and that it  
would be in the best interests of the public and the county that  
said agreement be entered into; and the Board being fully advised  
in the premises, it is therefore

**ORDERED** that Multnomah County enter into that certain  
agreement with Troutdale, Oregon, providing for the performance  
of functions and activities of local government involving viola-  
tion of ordinances of the City of Troutdale, all in accordance  
with the terms and conditions of that certain agreement tendered  
to the Board this date.

A G R E E M E N T.

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 19th day of  
December, 1968, by and between MULTNOMAH COUNTY,  
OREGON, and the CITY OF TROUTDALE, an incorporated City of the State  
of Oregon,

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, Multnomah County and the City of Troutdale are  
authorized pursuant to ORS 190.010-190.020 to enter into an agreement  
for the performance of functions and activities of local government;  
and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County and the City of Troutdale are  
authorized pursuant to ORS 46.010 (4) to enter into a cooperative  
agreement providing for the District Court of the State of Oregon for  
the County of Multnomah to have jurisdiction to hear and try violations  
of ordinances of the City of Troutdale; and

WHEREAS, Multnomah County and the City of Troutdale desire  
that jurisdiction to hear and determine cases involving violations  
of City ordinances of said City be vested in the District Court of  
the State of Oregon for the County of Multnomah for a period of one  
year from the date of this agreement and such course of action would be in  
the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein  
contained and pursuant to the purposes and authority heretofore stated,

IT IS AGREED as follows.

(1) For a period of one (1) year from the date of this agreement  
all violations of ordinances of the City of Troutdale now in effect or  
to become effective during said period shall be heard and determined  
exclusively in the District Court of the State of Oregon for the County  
of Multnomah and jurisdiction to hear said causes is conferred upon said  
court by consent and pursuant to this agreement of the parties.

(2) All fines and forfeitures resulting from said cases shall be remitted by the clerk of the District Court to the general fund of Multnomah County and shall become county funds.

(3) The City of Troutdale shall be responsible for the prosecution of said cases and the expenses incurred therein but shall not be required to bear any of the expenses of said court.

(4) Judgments of imprisonment in jail shall be executed by placing the prisoner in the Multnomah County Jail. The costs and expenses of said jail shall be borne by the City of Troutdale by reimbursing Multnomah County for such confinement at the rate of \$4.66 per day per prisoner to be paid on a monthly billing.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON, acting by and through its Chairman, Board of County Commissioners for Multnomah County, as authorized and directed by the Board of County Commissioners for Multnomah County, and TROUTDALE, OREGON, acting by and through its Mayor and Recorder, as duly authorized by its City Council, pursuant to resolution adopted by said Council, have caused said agreement to be executed on the day and year first above written.
