AN ORDIANCE RELATING TO THE TROUTDALE CITY JUDGE AND COURT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. Attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof is a true copy of an agreement entered into between the City of Troutdale and Multnomah County. So long as such agreement continues in effect, trials involving the violation of Troutdale City Ordinances shall be tried by a Judge of the District Court for the State of Oregon for the County of Multnomah.

SECTION 2. The trial and all proceedings in connection with the violation of Troutdale City Ordinances shall be conducted in all respects with all of the attendant rights that a defendant would have were he being tried in District Court for the violation of any criminal statute of the State of Oregon.

SECTION 3. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Troutdale and of the inhabitants thereof, and to preserve the credit of said City that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

## ACREEMENT.

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 19th day of

December , 1968, by and between MULTNOMAH COUNTY,

OREGON, and the CITY OF TROUTDILE, an incorporated City of the State
of Oregon,

## WITHESSETH:

whereas, Multnomah County and the City of Troutdale are authorized pursuant to ORS 190.010-190.020 to enter into an agreement for the performance of functions and activities of local government; and

whereas, Multnomah County and the City of Troutdale are authorized pursuant to CRS 46.010 (4) to enter into a cooperative agreement providing for the District Court of the State of Gregon for the County of Multnomah to have jurisdiction to hear and try violations of ordinances of the City of Troutdale; and

whereas, Multhoman County and the City of Troutdale desire
that jurisdiction to hear and determine cases involving violations
of City ordinances of said City be vested in the District Court of
the State of Oregon for the County of Multhoman for a period of one
year from the date of this agreement and such course of action would be in
the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained end pursuant to the purposes and suthority hereinsbove stated,

IT IS AGREED as follows.

(1) For a period of one (1) year from the date of this agreement all violations of ordinances of the City of Troutdale now in effect or to become effective during said period shall be heard and determined exclusively in the District Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Hultnomah and jurisdiction to hear said causes is conferred upon said court by consent and pursuant to this agreement of the parties.

Page 1---Agreement

421 All sames and forfaitures regulting from said cases shall mitted by the clerk of the District Court to the general fund of Multnomah County and shall become county funds.

(3) The City of Troutdate shall be responsible for the prosecution of said cases and the expenses incurred thereto but shall not be required to bear any of the expenses of said court.

(4) - Judgments of imprisonment in jell'shall be executed by placing the prisoner in the Multnomab County Jail. The costs and supperson of asid jail shall be borne by the City of Troutdale by reintersing bultnemak County for such confinement at the rate of \$4.66 per day yes prisoner to be paid on a monthly billing.

IN WITHESS WHEREOF, MULTNOMAH COUNTY, OREGON, acting by and through its Chairman, Board of County Commissioners for Multnomah County, as authorized and directed by the Board of County Commissioners for Multnomat. County, and TROUTDALE, OREGON, acting by and through its Mayor and Recorder, as duly suthorized by its City Council, pursuant to resolution adopted by said Council, have caused said agreement to be executed on the May and year first above written.
