

ORDINANCE NO. 130

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF TERRITORY SURROUNDED BY ITS CORPORATE LIMITS.

Whereas, the territory described below is surrounded by the corporate limits or boundaries of the City of Troutdale and is not an incorporated city; and

Whereas, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the city and the proposed area that the territory described below be annexed to the City without an election in the city; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Annexed Territory. The following described territory which is surrounded by the city boundaries is hereby annexed to the City of Troutdale:

A tract of land in Section 26, Township 1 North, Range 3 East described as follows:

Commencing at the most Westerly Southwest corner of the D.F. Buxton D.L.C.; thence Easterly along the Southerly line of said D.L.C., 1324.70 feet to a re-entrant corner of said D.F. Buxton D.L.C. on the East line of Section 26, Township 1 North, Range 3 East and the true point of beginning of the tract to be described; thence Westerly along the Southerly line of said D.L.C. 297.3 feet to the Southwest corner of a tract conveyed by deed recorded in Book 2072, page 335, on July 21, 1961 in Multnomah County Oregon, deed records; thence Northerly along the Westerly line of said tract and the Westerly line of a tract conveyed by deed recorded in Book 512, page 329 on September 6, 1939, 1320 feet more or less to the centerline of Sandy Road (No. 917-50); Thence Easterly along said centerline 295 feet more or less to the East line of Section 26, Township 1 North, Range 3 East; thence Southerly along said section line 1320 feet more or less to the point of beginning.

Section 2. Record. The city recorder shall submit to the Secretary of State of Oregon, the Multnomah County Assessor, and the Multnomah County Clerk a copy of this ordinance.
