

ORDINANCE NO. 132

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ZONING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE.

SECTION 1. To the extent applicable the comprehensive plan adopted by the City of Troutdale on the 30th day of November, 1967, shall be effective in all parts of the City annexed since the adoption of said Ordinance and shall be effective as to all areas hereinafter annexed.

SECTION 2. Where an area previously annexed or annexed in the future is not included in the comprehensive zoning plan adopted by Ordinance number 97, then the zoning in effect in said area by virtue of the Multnomah County Planning and Zoning Ordinance shall remain in effect until said zoning is changed by the City or until the adoption of a new comprehensive plan or until the adoption of a supplement to the existing comprehensive plan for the City of Troutdale.

SECTION 3. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Troutdale, and of inhabitants thereof, and to preserve the credit of said City that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
