AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SEWERS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 139, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE: OF ORDINANCe 139 SECTION 1.

Section 3-B_Ashall be amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 3-B The connection charge for all existing services for the period from the date of this Ordinance to December 31, 1969, shall be the sum of \$175.00. All persons required to connect to the initial sewer system shall have the option of paying the connection charge in periodic partial payments deposited with the City Recorder, for deposit into the "sewer fund", commencing immediately and running through the period ending December 31, 1969. Connection charges not paid in full by December 31, 1969, may be paid in six installments of \$30.00 each, there being a \$5.00 carrying charge for those desiring to pay such connection charge in installments. First of said installments shall be due on February 1st, 1969, and each subsequent installment shall be due on the 1st day of each month thereafter until said sum is fully paid. On the 1st day of January, 1970, the said service charge shall become a lien upon said property and may be foreclosed in the same manner as assessments are foreclosed as provided in Ordinance No. 128. On the 1st day of January, 1970, the Gounty Recorder shall enter in her record a list of the properties and the amounts due for each as connection charges. Said entries to become a part of the Lien Docket.

SECTION 2. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Troutdale, and of inhabitants thereof and to preserve the credit of said City that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
