

ORDINANCE NO. 142

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO CONCEALED WEAPONS  
AND THE DISCHARGE OF WEAPONS, AND DECLARING AN  
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE.

SECTION 1. Concealed Weapons. No person other than an authorized peace officer or person licensed pursuant to ORS. 166.290, as now or hereafter amended shall carry concealed on or about his person in any manner any revolver, pistol, other firearm, knife other than an ordinary pocketknife with a blade less than three and one-half inches long, dirk, dagger, stiletto, metal knuckles, or weapon the use of which could inflict injury upon a person or property.

SECTION 2. Discharge of Weapons.

1) No person other than an authorized peace officer shall fire or discharge a gun or other weapon, including spring or air-actuated pellet guns, air guns, or BB guns, or weapon which propels a projectile by use of gunpowder or other explosive, jet, or rocket propulsion.

2) The provisions of this section shall not be construed to prohibit the firing or discharging of a weapon by any person in the defense or protection of his property, person, or family, or from discharging a weapon in any facility approved as safe for such discharge by the Troutdale City Council. The said Council shall issue a permit to such facility on an annual basis. Provided further that this ordinance shall not apply to any such existing facility until on or after the 1st day of January, 1970. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to vest any interest in any existing person or property.

SECTION 3. Penalty for Violation. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof

be punished by a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of peace, health, and safety of the City of Troutdale, and of inhabitants thereof and to preserve the credit of said City that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
