

ORDINANCE NO. 145

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE TROUTDALE CITY
JUDGE AND COURT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. Attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof is a true copy of an Agreement entered into between the City of Troutdale and Multnomah County. So long as such agreement continues in effect, trials involving the violation of Troutdale City Ordinances for which prosecution commenced prior to the effective date of the said Agreement shall be tried by a Judge of the District Court for the State of Oregon for the County of Multnomah.


SECTION 2. The trial and all proceedings in connection with the violation of Troutdale City Ordinances shall be conducted in all respects with all of the attendant rights that a defendant would have were he being tried in District Court for the violation of any criminal statute of the State of Oregon.

SECTION 3. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Troutdale and of the inhabitants thereof, and to preserve the credit of said City that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
