ORDINANCE NO. 149

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF TERRITORY SURROUNDED BY ITS CORPORATE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the territory described below is surrounded by the corporate limits or boundaries of the City of Troutdale and is not an incorporated city; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the city and the proposed area that the territory described below be annexed to the city without an election in the city; now therefore,

The City of Troutdale ordains as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. Annexed Territory. The following described territory which is surrounded by the city boundaries is hereby annexed to the City of Troutdale:

A tract of land situated in the J. Douglas D.L.C. in Section 36, Township 1 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:


Commencing at the intersection of the south line of said Douglass D.L.C. with the center line of Troutdale Road (County Road No. 533-50); thence North along the center line of said County Road, a distance of 349.5 feet to the northwest corner of a 15 acre tract sold by Douglass to Richardson in 1892, said point being the true point of beginning of the tract herein to be described; thence tracing the north line of said Richardson tract and parallel with the south line of said Douglass D.L.C., a distance of 1862.6 feet to a point in the east line of said D.L.C.; thence North tracing said east line 594 feet; thence West parallel with the south line of said Douglass D.L.C. 1861.4 feet, more or less to a point in the center line of said Troutdale Road; thence South along said center line 594 feet to the true point of beginning.

SECTION 2. Record. The city recorder shall submit to the Secretary of State of Oregon, the Multnomah County Assessor, and the Multnomah County Clerk a copy of this ordinance.

(Boundary Change Proposal No. 155.)

ORDER

WHEREAS, a petition for annexation of certain territory contiguous to the City of Troutdale, Oregon, described as follows:

A tract of land situated in the J. Douglass D.L.C. in Section 36, Township 1 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the south line of said Douglass D.L.C. with the center line of Troutdale Road (County Road No. 533-50); thence North along the center line of said County Road, a distance of 349.5 feet to the northwest corner of a 15 acre tract sold by Douglass to Richardson in 1892, said point being the true point of beginning of the tract herein to be described; thence East tracing the north line of said Richardson tract and parallel with the south line of said Douglass D.L.C., a distance of 1862.6 feet to a point in the east line of said D.L.C.; thence North tracing said east line 594 feet; thence West parallel with the south line of said Douglass D.L.C. 1861.4 feet, more or less to a point in the center line of said Troutdale Road; thence South along said center line 594 feet to the true point of beginning.

was initiated under Section 16 of Chapter 494, Oregon Session Laws 1969; and

WHEREAS, the Portland Metropolitan Area Local Government Boundary Commission has made a study of said annexation and approved said annexation of May 20, 1970; and

WHEREAS, the City of Troutdale has not protested the annexation within forty-five (45) days, and said annexation having therefore become final; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid territory is now subject to the rules and regulations of the Planning Authority of the City of Troutdale, and is no longer within the jurisdiction of the Multnomah County Planning Commission, and the Board, at this time, being fully advised in the premises; now, therefore, it is hereby

ORDERED that as of July 6, 1970, the above territory is no longer within the control and authority of the Multnomah County Planning Commission and the Multnomah County Planning Commission is directed to remove the said territory from the Zoning Map and Comprehensive Plan of Multnomah County; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Board transmit to the City Recorder of the City of Troutdale, Oregon, a copy of this order.

FINAL ORDER

RE: BOUNDARY CHANGE PROPOSAL NO. 155 - Annexation of the following territory to the City of Troutdale

Legal Description

A tract of land situated in the J. Douglass D.L.C. in Section 36, Township 1 North, Range 3 East of the Willamette Meridian, County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the south line of said Douglass D.L.C. with the center line of Troutdale Road (County Road No. 533-50); thence North along the center line of said County Road, a distance of 349.5 feet to the northwest corner of a 15 acre tract sold by Douglass to Richardson in 1892, said point being the true point of beginning of the tract herein to be described; thence East tracing the north line of said Richardson tract and parallel with the south line of said Douglass D.L.C., a distance of 1862.6 feet to a point in the east line of said D.L.C.; thence North tracing said east line 594 feet; thence West parallel with the south line of said Douglass D.L.C. 1861.4 feet, more or less to a point in the center line of said Troutdale Road; thence South along said center line 594 feet to the true point of beginning.

WHEREAS, on April 21, 1970, the Commission received a resolution from the City Council of Troutdale requesting that the property described above be annexed to the City;

WHEREAS, the resolution meets the requirements for initiating boundary change proposals in ORS 222.750 and paragraph (a), Section (1) or ORS 199.495;

WHEREAS, the Commission duly published notice of public hearing in accordance with ORS 199.520 and conducted a public hearing on May 20, 1970, in accordance with the rules of the Commission and paragraph (b), Section (1) of ORS 199.475;

WHEREAS, the Commission caused a study to be made of this proposal as provided in paragraph (a), Section (1) or ORS 199.475;

WHEREAS, on the basis of the study which considered economic, demographic, and sociological trends and physical development of the land, and the public hearing, the Commission found that:

- a) the territory to be annexed is contiguous to the city by being completely surrounded by the corporate limits of the city;
- b) the territory to be annexed contains approximately 25 acres, two single family dwellings and an estimated population of 8 persons;
- c) the City Council initiated the boundary change because it determined that it is "in the best interest of the city and the proposed area that the territory...be annexed to the city";
- d) the territory to be annexed is included within the study area for the city's Comprehensive Land Use Plan (now underway), Sewerage Plan (recently completed, and Water Plan (now underway); and
- e) the territory when developed can most logically be served by the City's water and sewer systems.

WHEREAS, on the basis of the findings the Commission approved BOUNDARY CHANGE PROPOSAL NO. 155 on May 20, 1970;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED THAT the territory described above be annexed to the City of Troutdale as of this date.

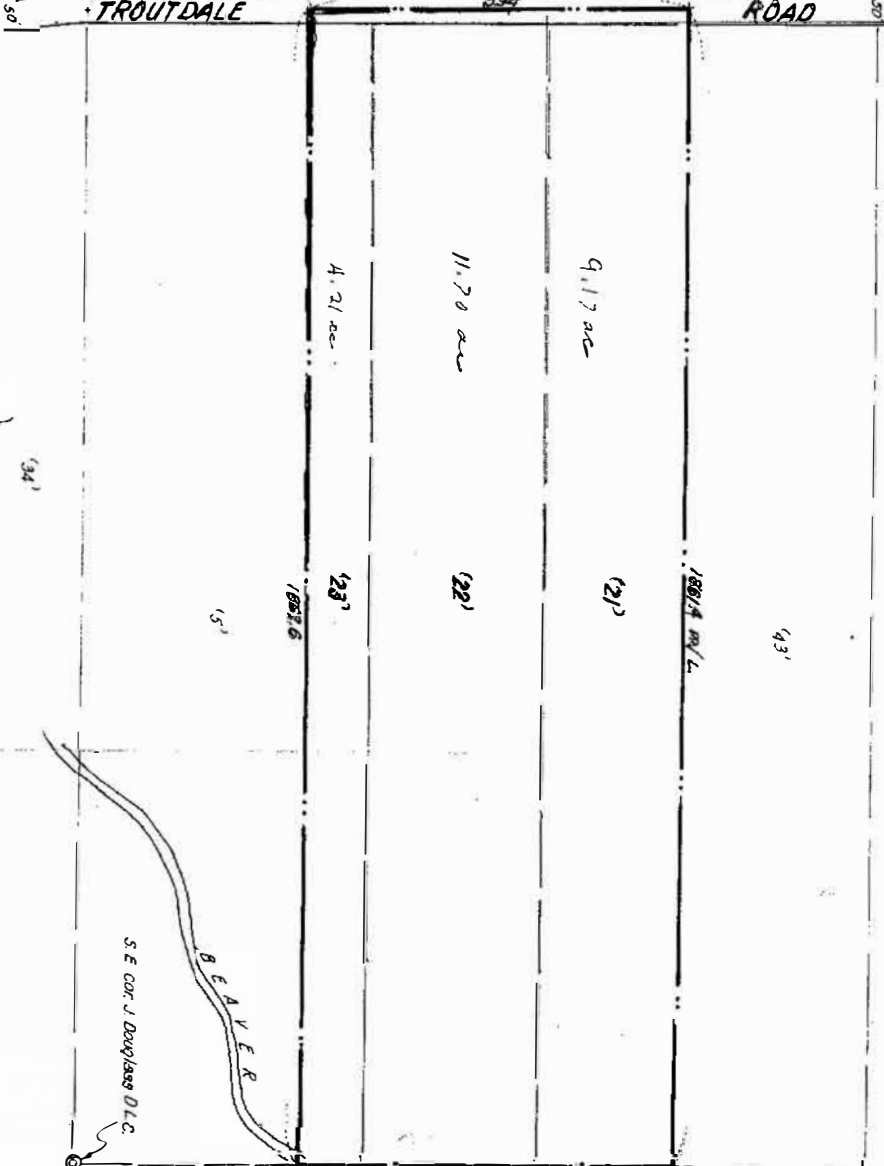

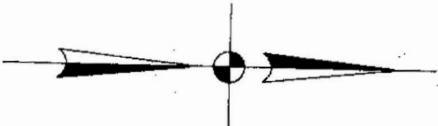
