

ORDINANCE NO. 157

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE REGULATING AND LICENSING OF PRIVATE BUSINESSES AND OCCUPATION IN THE CITY OF TROUTDALE, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 115, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:


SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 2, entitled LICENSE REQUIRED, of Ordinance number 115 shall be amended to read as follows: No person shall operate, sell, lease, distribute or maintain any device, vehicle, thing or establishment, specified in this Code or engage in any business, profession, trade or calling, unless he has a license from the City. The annual license fee is \$15.00 and shall be on a calendar year basis. By special action of the Council, a license for less than a year may be issued at any time.

SECTION 2. That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Troutdale, and of inhabitants thereof and to preserve the credit of said City that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


