

ORDINANCE NO. 158

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A SEWAGE COLLECTION AND TREATMENT SYSTEM: AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 147, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1: Section 6-B of Ordinance number 147 shall be amended to read as follows: Sewer service charges as and when collected shall be paid into a fund designated as the "Sewer Operating Fund."


SECTION 2: Section 8-A subsections 1, 2 and 3 of Ordinance 147 shall be amended to read as follows: The Council, by resolution or motion duly adopted, shall from time to time and not less than once each fiscal year, direct the disbursement of funds for the construction, operation, or maintenance of the sewage system and/or direct the transfer of funds to the account or accounts for the payment of principal and interest on maturing sewer bonds and/or the account or accounts established for a sinking fund to meet future interest and principal obligations on sewer bonds.

SECTION 3: That whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the City of Troutdale, and of inhabitants thereof and to preserve the credit of said City that this ordinance take effect immediately; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


