## ORDINANCE NO. 162

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CITY WATER SUPPLY, AMENDING GRDINANCE NO. 99 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Chapter 2 of Ordinance 99 is swended by the addition of a Section 6 which reads as follows:

Section 5. Whenever an existing metered water supply within or without the City of Troutdale is disconnected for whatever reason, before such system will be reconnected, a reconnection charge of FIVS AND NO/160ths (\$5.00) DOLLARS shall be required, which shall be psyable in advance. Such reconnection charge shall be in addition to any outstanding obligation for water supplied to such premises.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Troutdala in the judgment of the Common Council, now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, and its signing by the Meyor.
