

ORDINANCE NO. 164

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CITY WATER SUPPLY,
AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM, AMENDING ORDINANCE
NO. 99 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
TROUTDALE;

Section 1. Chapter 2 of Ordinance 99 is amended so that
Section 5 shall read as follows:

Section 5. All water charges and sewer service
charges including those referred to in Ordinance
No. 147, whether within or without Troutdale,
shall be chargeable to the premises where water
is supplied, Whenever any water charge or sewer
service charge shall not be paid within ten (10)
days after it becomes due and payable, the Marshall
shall discontinue the service of water to such
premises, Water shall not again be furnished thereto
until all outstanding obligations for water and
sewer service charges to said premises, shall have
been paid in full.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for
the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety
of the people of the City of Troutdale in the judgment of the Common
Council, now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its
passage by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, and its
signing by the Mayor,
