

ORDINANCE NO. 168

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC CONTROL. AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 155. PROVIDING A TERMINATION DATE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Ordinance No. 155, the powers there delegated to the Traffic Control Board and the designation and regulation of traffic by said Board, business establishments located on Columbia Street having no entrance or land abutting any dedicated street or alley other than Columbia Street may be issued parking permits for the following purposes, and under the following conditions:

Commercial delivery vehicles used for making deliveries to such establishments shall be issued a parking permit designating that it may be parked on <sup>the south side of</sup> Columbia during the time the driver thereof is loading and unloading and doing those things necessarily connected thereto, upon a request by the business to be served and the payment of \$ 2.00. This permit may be revoked upon a finding by the Traffic Control Board that the provisions of this ordinance have been violated.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become inoperable on the 30th day of April, 1972.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Troutdale in the judgment of the Common Council, now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, and its signing by the Mayor.
