

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF MOTOR PROPELLED VEHICLES ON PUBLIC OR PRIVATE PROPERTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROUTDALE:

SECTION 1. No person shall operate or permit to be operated a motor vehicle on public or private property by any person unless such person shall have a valid Motor Vehicle Operating License.

a. Any motor device used as a mode of transportation.

SECTION 2. Operation or permission to operate as described in Section 1 is hereby declared to be a nuisance. Upon conviction of violation thereof, such person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or imprisonment in jail for not more than one year, or both.

SECTION 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Troutdale in the judgement of the Common Council, now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of the City of Troutdale, and its signing by the Mayor.


